INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES

Our website (www.torquelaw.co.uk) uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. We use cookies to personalise content and advertisements, to provide social media features and to analyse our traffic. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site. We also share information about your use of our site with our social media, advertising and/or analytics partners who may combine it with other information that you've provided to them or that they've collected from your use of their services.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

The law states that we can store cookies on your device if they are strictly necessary for the operation of this site. For all other types of cookies, we need your permission. By continuing to browse the site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

MARKETING

Cookie name	Provider	Purpose	Expiry	Type
Collect	google-analytics.com	Used to send data to Google Analytics about the visitor's device and behaviour. Tracks the visitor across devices and marketing channels	Session	Pixel tracker
